

Tackling Health Inequalities in the Gypsy Traveller Community



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WHY??



- Gypsy and Traveller women are estimated to live
 12 years less than women in the general
 population and men 10 years less, although recent
 research suggests the gap could be much higher
- Three times as likely to die by suicide than the general population.
- Three times more likely to be anxious than average and just over twice as likely to be depressed
- High prevalence of substance misuse/Diabetes

The MBRRACE report into maternal deaths (2018) showed that **Black women were five times** more likely to die in pregnancy or within 42 days of giving birth.

Traveller community have the poorest maternal and neonatal outcomes of any BAME group.



Kernow Maternity Voices Partnership

Independent NHS body focussed on service user engagement and coproduction

We are led by service users and passionate about working towards better births for all in Cornwall and IOS



During planning of a month long engagement activity we identified Gypsy and traveller women as a group of seldom heard service users who had much poorer outcomes than any other group in Cornwall

TravellerSpace provided vital links and introductions to the community and a space to carry out engagement.



Participatory appraisal techniques- Creative and visual feedback boards

Issues to overcome included literacy levels, understanding of language, concentration levels, busy and noisy environment, standard questionnaires and feedback forms not effective, lack of trust.

Understanding Culture
Recognise stereotypes and bias
Accepting difference
Listening and respecting stories



We don't learn from talking; we learn from listening. Graphic facilitation allowed the women and children to get involved and really see how their voices were being recorded.

We visited multiple times, building trust and relationships.

Getting to know the women and their stories.

Understanding the barriers for them and signposting to support.

Feedback taken straight to HoM who then accompanied us to the group

- AN, PN and hopefully intrapartum care.
- Small caseload of 4.
- High rates of twins, still birth, late miscarriage, premature delivery and neonatal death, low birth weight below 10th centile.
- o% vaccination rate flu vaccine and whooping cough

- AN appointments
- Bloods
- Immunisations
- Health promotion/education
- Continuity of Carer
- Attend scans/consultant appointments
 Partnership working (HV, Housing officer, Charity, MVP, named SW, named Consultant)
- Simplify where possible



Outcomes...

- 100% vaccination rate for whooping cough
- Willingness to engage with smoking cessation, attempts to reduce.
- Prolonged pregnancy
- Continuity of carer- AN, IP, PN
- 0% staff sickness
- Job satisfaction
- Empowered midwives and empowered women
- Positive feedback from women

- High dependency on urgent care
